

LMDC Wellness Policy



For the comfort of your child and in consideration of the health of the other children and staff, please do not send a sick or potentially compromised child to school.

A child may not attend LMDCTP with any of the following conditions:

*three or more immunization doses within one 24-hour period.¹

*fever, 100 degrees or higher

*strep throat

*vomiting

* diarrhea

*any childhood diseases

*eye infections (pink eye)

*cough with fever

*undiagnosed rash

*discharge from the eyes

*lice, nits, or scabies

Medicines

¹ Parents of students receiving three or more immunization doses in a single 24-hour period must monitor their child's condition away from LMDCTP for at least 12 to 24 hours after the final dose.

Each child will have his/her own box, labeled with their name at day care to keep the following: diaper creams, band aids, teething rings, etc.

This box will be filled and maintained by the parents.

Immunization Requirements

Children must be current with immunizations and may not be enrolled without proof of a immunization record. This must be presented to LMDCTP and immunizations are up-to-date.

These are the state REQUIRED immunizations for your child's first 3 years of life. Timelines of REQUIRED vaccinations by age, a schedule of immunizations, can be provided by your doctor.

***Polio, 3 doses in the course of 3 years of age.**

***DTP or DTap, 4 doses in the course of 3 years of age.**

***Hep B, 3 doses in the course of 3 years of age. Three doses meet by TK.**

***MMR, (measles, mumps & rubella) One dose by one year of age.**

***Hib, one dose given before or by age 1 year. Three doses meet by TK.**

*** Varicella /Chickenpox vaccine, one dose given by age 1 year. Two doses meet by TK.**

***ALL other vaccines are voluntary and NOT required to attend LMDCTP school.**

Inhaled Medications at Day Care

Under the California health and Safety Code 1596.798, child care providers in California can assist children in their care with nebulizers and other inhaled medications. However, child care providers must meet certain conditions to administer and assist with these procedures, please consult your child's Doctor.

Parents will be notified by phone if their child has a fever during their day at LMDCTP. A fever is 100 degrees or higher by LMDCTP Policy. Parents will be expected to pick up the child as soon as they can. To return to school, a child must be fever free for 24 hours at home. When a virus is believed to be present in the child, (100-degree fever or higher) the safest course of action is for the child to be kept in a quarantine crib, in a quiet spot, the parent is notified and then, placing the child/student on 24 hour fever free status at home. If the child has not needed medication and has been fever free for 24 hours, then they can return to school.

If the child is vomiting, the parent must come to LMDCTP immediately to pick up the child, or the first emergency contact or legal guardian will be notified to come and pick up the child.
